Please note that we are following advice from Catholic Education Melbourne in regard to the management of Corona Virus. Please read the attached notification further on in the newsletter. In line with a number of other schools and current health advice, we are needing to commence the following practices -

From Monday 16th March

Direct drinking from the school bubblers will be withdrawn. Each student is to have their water bottle with them to use inside and they will also take it with them outside during recesses.

Bottles will be refilled as required.

Each student is to bring a toilet bag containing soap in a soap container and a small hand towel. Supervised hand washing will take place throughout the day. Students will also take their toiletries to the bathroom with them during individual visits. Hand towels are to be taken home each afternoon for washing and drying and returned the following day. These actions will be in addition to current practices.

Thank you for your support and understanding as we work together to promote best practice.

Dear Parents and Guardians

Our first priority at St Brigid's is the health and safety of our school community.

I want to reassure you that the school is well-prepared for the impact of COVID-19 (coronavirus).

We are being provided the latest advice from the Australian and Victorian Chief Medical Officers by the Catholic Education Commission of Victoria Ltd to ensure that our school practices are helping to keep our school community safe from the outbreak.
