Our teaching staff, including the principal, know each child by name and care for and accept them for who they are. We challenge ourselves to become familiar with each student's strengths and needs so we can tailor our learning methods to have the most positive impact. We place a strong emphasis on individual welfare, administer a consistent approach to behavioural management, and have a student wellbeing team that meets regularly.



We welcome and encourage parent involvement in our school. Whether in the classroom, on school excursions, special days or activity nights, involvement is highly valued. Research tells us that parent involvement improves students academic, social and emotional wellbeing.
